

Consequences of Not Completing Project

- Default on a Federal Transportation Administration grant:
 - ASSOCIATED COSTS

Total Grant Paid:		895,404.00
Total Interest Due (to April 2014):		69,138.39
Total Match paid by JTA:		258,359.90
Total for Uncompleted Project:	\$	1,222,902.29

- JEOPARDIZE FUTURE FTA GRANT FUNDING
 - 77% of our 2013-2015 Operating Grant was Federal FTA funding
 - Current Depot Construction Necessary for Occupation: Storm Water Abatement
 - New Underground Storage Tank (Within 10 Years)
 - Capital Purchases (Vehicles) funded by FTA

How will these projects be funded???



Consequences of Not Completing Project

- Lose \$365K STP Construction Funding for Wash Facility/Fuel Island
- Jefferson County loses on benefits of construction:
 - Loss of revenue from construction
 - No employment benefit from project
 - Loss from non-development of site




Benefits

Construction Estimate vs. Apparent Low Bid

- Pease Construction bid = \$4,625,000
- Architect Construction Estimate = \$4,238,850
 - Areas where the bid was significantly higher than estimate.
 - Special Construction (Metal Building and Fabric Structure)
 - Electrical
 - Exterior Improvements (Paving, landscaping, fencing, etc.)
 - HVAC ***
