| INDEX OF JEFFERSON TRANSIT RECORDS |

A RESOLUTION, stating that maintaining a current index of Jefferson Transit records would be unduly burdensome and that, pursuant to RCW 42.56.070, such a current index will not be maintained.

WHEREAS, Jefferson Transit is a municipal corporations of the State of Washington, which provides public transportation benefit area (PTBA) services to Jefferson County residents and others; and

WHEREAS, under RCW 46.586.070 a local agency need not maintain a current index of its public records if maintaining such an index would be unduly burdensome, and if it issues and publishes a formal order specifying the reasons why and the extent to which maintaining the index would unduly burden or interfere with agency operations; and

WHEREAS, the magnitude and diversity of transit system governance has resulted in the creation or retention of a multitude of records, which would be extremely difficult, time-consuming, and costly to index and maintain in a single current index; and

WHEREAS, the performance of the transit system's overall mission does not allow the addition to or the revision or reassignment of current duties of existing personnel so that a current index could be developed and maintained without the addition of staff; and

WHEREAS, neither current nor reasonably-anticipated future transit system revenues are considered adequate to allow for the addition of new staff members who could be assigned to develop and maintain a current index; and

WHEREAS, Jefferson Transit has a longstanding and recognized policy of assisting people who request public information and providing records upon request.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Jefferson Transit Authority Board as follows:

Section 1. For the reasons set out above, maintaining and updating a public records index as discussed in RCW 42.56.070 would be unduly burdensome to the safe and efficient operations of Jefferson Transit. For these reasons, such an index would not be maintained as authorized by that statute.
