Accessibility

Kitsap Transit ferries and gangways are wheelchair friendly. Crewmembers will help to ensure a safe and secure ride. There are a limited number of first-come, first served spaces devoted to wheelchairs.



Bicycles

Bicycles are welcome aboard on a first-come, first-served basis. Crew members will direct passengers on a secure placement. Shoes with metal sports cleats are not allowed in passenger areas.



Pets

Only service animals are allowed in Kitsap Transit buildings, vessels or buses (the only exception are small animals (25 lbs. or less) inside enclosed pet containers).
