The Fare Policy of the Jefferson Transit Authority shall be determined by the Jefferson Transit

Authority Board based on the Jefferson Transit's needs; the general population's needs and shall

change from time to time as Jefferson Transit's needs change and as public attitudes and

priorities change to ensure the maintenance of an equitable, logical, consistent and fiscally

responsible fare structure.

The Goals of the Policy are to:

Encourage Ridership;

Maintain Equity based upon service type and cost;

Maintain passenger convenience and ease of understanding;

Maintain operating convenience and cost control;

Minimize the economic hardship of inhibiting ridership.

Fare Structure:

1. All passengers 18 years of age and younger shall ride free of charge regardless of type of

service provided.

2. All passengers travelling on service labeled as regular fixed route/dial-a-ride service shall

ride free of charge.

3. All service labeled as Premium or Express shall charge passengers (except those listed in

Item #1) fares based on revenue miles and hours while balancing promotion of ridership

and route cost.
