**WHEREAS**, Jefferson Transit Authority is committed to taking an environmental leadership role in reducing both community emissions and JTA fleet emissions; and





**RESOLUTION NO. 23-17**

**A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT AN AMENDED AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT (ADA) POLICY**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Directors of the Jefferson County Public Transportation Benefit Area d.b.a. Jefferson Transit Authority (“Board”) adopted the ADA Policy in 1992 and last amended in 2021; and


**WHEREAS**, the policy addresses public transit requirements for accessibility and the provision of service, including access to fixed route bus and complementary paratransit service; and

**WHEREAS**, the policy adheres to ADA guidelines provided by the Federal Transit Association (FTA) and Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT); and

**WHEREAS**, Jefferson Transit Authority wishes to amend this policy to reflect WSDOT recommendations. Revisions were made to the following components: complaint process, paratransit service boundaries, trip denials, ADA complimentary trip scheduling, origin to destination service, and retention periods;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** the Board does hereby adopt the amended ADA Policy dated June 20, 2023, as set forth in ‘Exhibit A’ which is attached to this Resolution.
